## Annual Appeal Update

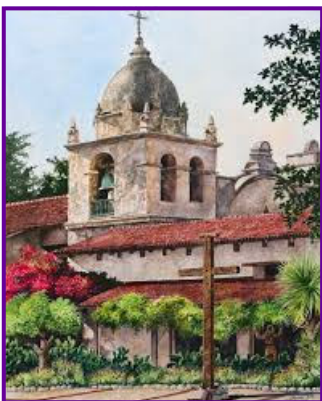
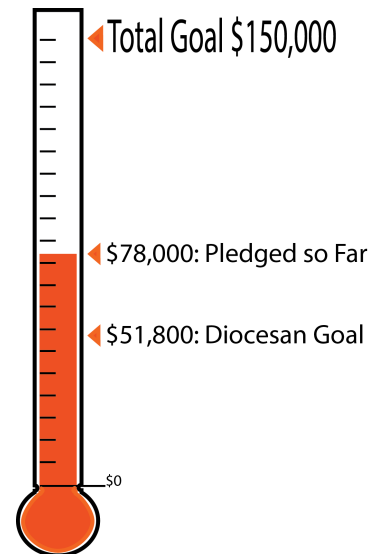
A heartfelt and prayerful thank you to all of you who have contributed to our Crespi project.

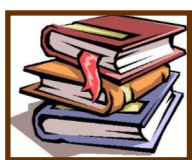

**New Book Club Selection**

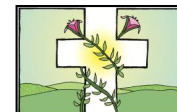

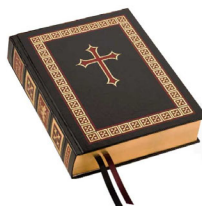

### Theology on Tap Confirmation: *What's in It for Me?*

### DOCENT CORNER

#### St. John the Baptist



If you look into the baptistery at the entrance to the left side of the church you will see a painting of St. John the Baptist on the far wall. Many churches have him as a fixture in the baptistery. We know that he was the cousin of Jesus Christ and is highly regarded as a prophet by 4 religions: Christianity, Islam, Mandaeism, and the Bahá'í Faith. His feast day is June 24<sup>th</sup>.

John was the son of Zachary, a priest of the Temple in Jerusalem, and Elizabeth, a kinswoman of Mary, the mother of Jesus. When Mary visited Elizabeth (known as The Visitation), John jumped for joy in his mother's womb. John lived as a hermit in the desert of Judea and began to preach on the banks of the Jordan against the evils of the times and called men to penance and baptism. He attracted large crowds, and when Christ came to him for baptism, John recognized Him as the Messiah. John inspired many of his followers to follow Christ.

Fearful of his great power with the people, Herod Antipas, had him arrested and imprisoned. John had also denounced Herod's adulterous and incestuous marriage. His treacherous wife persuaded her daughter, Salome, to trick Herod and asked for John's head on a silver platter. Herod had him beheaded.

He is the patron saint of Puerto Rico and its capital city, San Juan, bears his name. Actually, in 1521 Columbus named the island "San Juan Bautista" and named the city "Puerto Rico". The reversal of the names was due largely to a map-making error. By 1746, the name for the city had become the name of the entire island, while the name for the island had become the name for the city.

He is also the patron saint of French Canada, baptism, Genoa, Italy, motorways, Palermo, Sicily and many others. St. John's College at Oxford and St. John's University in NY were named after him and Quebec has an annual provincial holiday in his honor.

The painting in the baptistery was reputedly done by colonial master Jose de Páez. It arrived here in 1774.

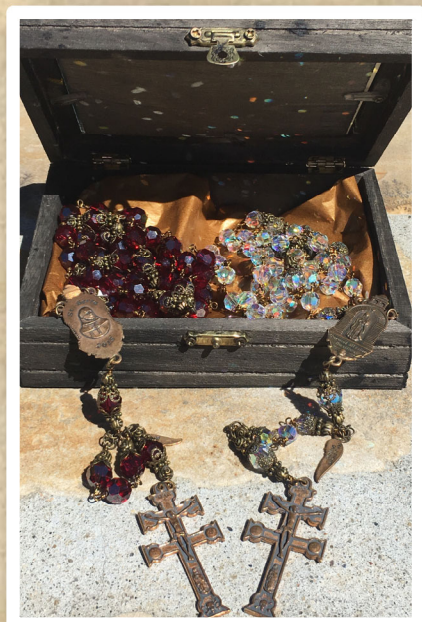
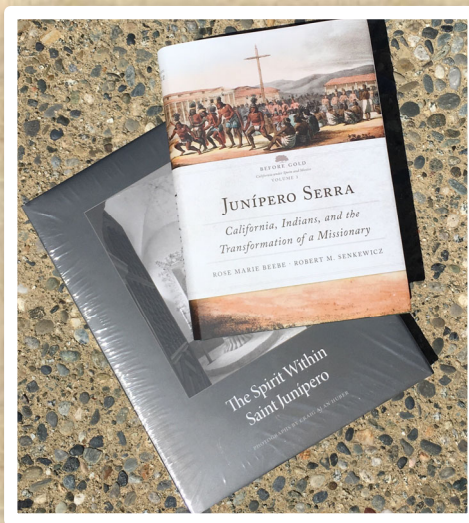
