



FR. PAUL'S WEEKLY LETTER

Dear Friend of Carmel Mission,

I hope and pray that you and your loved ones are safe and sound, and that the New Year has started well for you.

It's that time of year when we launch our Annual Ministries Appeal (AMA), our sole fundraiser for the needs of our parish. For successive years now, your response to this appeal has been truly amazing. As we celebrated the 250th Anniversary last year, we set ourselves the goal of raising \$250,000.00. Your generosity enabled us to raise in excess of \$300,000.00! This year we will again pursue a goal of \$250,000. The first \$55,700 raised goes to diocesan ministries, and any amount we raise over that sum comes back to our parish.

During the Covid 19 pandemic, we have put in place a series of procedures and protocols that are aimed at keeping you as safe and sound as possible. We have identified further measures that will enhance your safety and security when you come to your parish. These measures include improving access, parking, lighting, signage, security, wireless infrastructure, and audio-visual resources.

We also hope to expand and improve our Museum exhibits. We anticipate an increase in the number of visitors to our historic and sacred site, and, of course, the reactivation of our many parish ministries onsite. In the coming weeks, we will highlight the specific areas in need of support through this AMA campaign in our bulletin.

We have a wonderful story to share with the world, and we are in the best position to share it. The history of our beautiful Mission is a story of advancement through adversity. We stand on sacred ground, aware of the treasures that have been passed down to us, proud of our heritage and convinced of the gospel values that we seek to pass on to future generations.

I'm requesting your assistance to enable us to further advance through present adversity.

Will you invest in the future of your Mission parish, while at the same time helping many diocesan ministries?

Will you give to our 2022 AMA Campaign so that you and all who come our way will feel safe and sound here?

Scripture Message

The first reading from the Book of Sirach, a Wisdom book, helps prepare us for what Jesus has to say in the Gospel. Sirach says that the fruit of the tree shows how it has been cared for, and that what a person says is the best guide to what is in their heart. Tribulation tests us like the furnace does to pottery, and like the clay, we are made stronger by the tribulation we experience. In the Gospel Jesus cautions us against judging others before we look honestly at our own weaknesses and flaws. Like the reading from Sirach Jesus uses a horticultural reference. Healthy trees and bushes that are cared for and nourished produce healthy fruit. Trees and bushes that are sickly or neglected do not produce. Good words and actions come from the fullness of good hearts. What feeds our hearts influences our words and our words guide our actions. Jesus encourages us to fill our hearts with that which is good, and the psalmist offers guidance on how we can do this, by praising God. Those whose energy is spent contemplating, considering and praising the goodness and kindness of God will flourish like healthy, well-tended plants.

St. Patrick's Day

According to the Confessio of Patrick, when he was about 16, he was captured by Irish pirates from his home in Great Britain, and taken as a slave to Ireland, looking after animals, where he lived for six years before escaping and returning to his family. After becoming a cleric, he returned to northern and western Ireland. In later life, he served as a bishop, but little is known about the places where he worked. By the seventh century, he had already come to be revered as the patron saint of Ireland. Saint Patrick's Day is observed on March 17, the supposed date of his death. It is celebrated inside and outside Ireland as a religious and cultural holiday.







Our Advent theme, I Am For You, reminds us that our loving God is always on our side, despite any difficulties that we may have to encounter.




